What is the TAM Portal?

With the passage of MAP-21, there is great interest among transportation agencies to advance transportation asset management (TAM) implementation efforts.

The AASHTO TAM Portal offers TAM practitioners a central location that organizes and provides access to a curated set of high-value TAM resources, news, and event listings.

To ensure that users will find what they need quickly and efficiently, resources are stored in an easily searchable database and indexed by factors such as asset type, audience, agency business process, and others.

In the last several years, a wealth of information on transportation asset management has been developed as the results of research studies, peer exchanges, conferences, webinars, and other efforts.

Much of the information is available to practitioners but is spread out in a number of different locations, making it difficult and time-consuming to find.

As a result, practitioners spend an inordinate amount of time searching for information to assist them in their implementation of asset management.

The TAM portal fills the need for an interface for asset management practitioners. It facilitates access to useful information in a simple, expedited manner.
