




Relationship of Transportation Asset Management to Performance Management

- Project focus


Opportunity - Asked to develop risk workshop for AM Conference in Dubai

Developed mini-course (half-day) based on NHI framework

- Distilled down to five basic steps less than 30 slides
- Followed NHI for two reasons:
  - It was what others were likely to be familiar with
  - It was what I had most recently been exposed to
- Limited time eliminates exercises, which likely harms efficacy




### Five basic steps
